Dear Mohammad,

Following the recent infection prevention and control audit completed at your practice on January 20th 2015, I am pleased to confirm the results and put these results into the context of the national framework set by the Infection Prevention Society. The audit covered a comprehensive series of questions encompassing your clinical environment and practices.

The benchmark thresholds are set by the Infection Prevention Society for which the three categories are as follows:

- 85% and above – Good Standard of Compliance,
- 76% to 84% - Satisfactory Standard of Compliance,
- 75% and below – Poor Standard of Compliance.

The colour coding used throughout the infection control audit report indicates the level of compliance to each individual audit question:

- Green – Full Compliance
- Amber – Non-Compliance following Expert Guidance
- Red – Non-Compliance following Legislation
- Pale Yellow – Not Applicable.

The overall score from the independent audit at your premises was 85% which demonstrates that the practice has achieved a good standard of compliance.
